- Riverbank
- Bamboo Grove
- Rocky Hills
- Grasslands

They recorded the number of deer, monkeys, elephants, and peacocks seen in each zone.

Observation Table:

Animals	Riverbank	Bamboo grove	Rocky hills	Grassland
Deer	12	18	6	20
Monkey	5	22	2	10
Elephant	8	3	15	4
Peacock	10	7	3	12

Represent the data using a bar graph.

- In which zone were most animals spotted in total?
- Which animal was least spotted in the Bamboo Grove?
- Which zone had more monkeys spotted Bamboo Grove or Grassland and by how many?
- Calculate the total number of animals spotted in the Grasslands.
- Create a tally chart to represent the data for any two animals.
